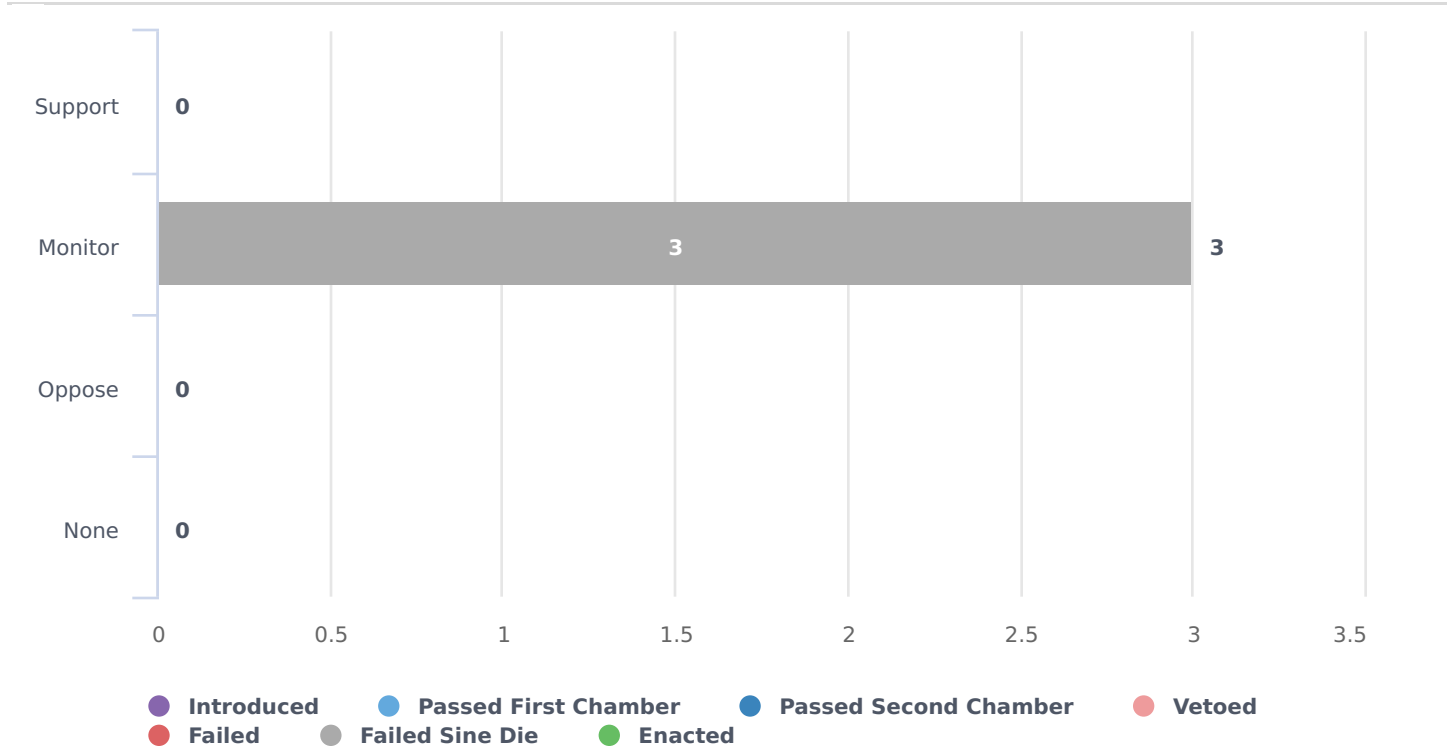

Bill Summary: Last edited by Jeff Plummer at Feb 2, 2023, 3:59 PM
Amends Title 17 (Food and Drugs), Chapter 30 (Controlled Substances), Article 5 (Controlled Substance Prescription Database) of Alaska Statutes to exempt veterinarians from the requirements of the Controlled Substance Prescription Database. Strikes the Board of Veterinary Examiners from the current provision that they notify the State Medical Board when a practitioner (veterinarian) registers with the Controlled Substance Prescription Database under Section (n) which reads: A pharmacist who dispenses or a practitioner who prescribes, administers, or directly dispenses a schedule II, III, or IV controlled substance under federal law shall register with the database by a procedure and in a format established by the board.

Adds to the provision in current statute that every person has a right to inspect a public record in the state, including public records in recorders' offices, EXCEPT - "records that include names, addresses, or other information identifying a person who has adopted or is providing foster care for an animal."
